Free Siddha medical outpatient hospital functions in the Palace Campus of Tamil University. 100 of publics make use of this service every month. Siddha medicine is also distributed to them at nominal cost. Tamil University National Service Scheme organized 7 days camp at Pillaiyarpatti village; Cleaning of Temples, streets and schools, awareness programmes on hygiene, environmental protection, national integration, social harmony etc..

Tamil University students have major role in organizing world mother's tongue day celebration and procession and dispatching notices to public on the importance of mother tongue.

Free Eye Camp was conducted with help of Aravind Eye Hospital, Madurai

Blood donation and Blood Group testing were conducted for the public and the staff with the help of Red Cross Society.

Red Ribbon Club was conducted an awareness programme on AIDS was made.

Community radio service was inaugurated.
