To establish multi disciplinary scientific research approach to strengthen the traditional system of medicine, the Department of Siddha Medicine under the Faculty of Science was established in 1982 at Tamil University in Thanjavur. The Department functions as four categories like literary research, Laboratory research, Siddha clinical research and Herbal garden. Among the available palm leaf manuscripts 60% of them are on Siddha Medicine. The activities include collection, documentation and publication of palm leaf manuscripts. So far, this unit has published 12 books on Siddha Medical literature. It conserve and multiply the rare and endangered medicinal plants through tissue culture. Herbal garden was established in about 5 acres of land in the University campus in 1983 to provide primarily to the needs of the Siddha Department and to the local physicians of indigenous medicine.

To make the traditional Siddha System of Medicine available in literature to reach the common people and to do clinical research, the department has started a clinical outpatient unit in 1992. In the clinical outpatient unit, various kinds of internal and external medicines are given to patients for the treatment.

The Department offers the academic programme viz., M.Phil., and Ph.D., in Siddha Medicine /Biochemistry / Microbiology/Pharmacology /Pharmaceuticals/Medicinal Botany. Keeping in view the department gives research & development support for academic, research institutes and industry.

Objectives of the Department

- To establish the efficacies of Siddha drugs on modern scientific basis using Botanical, Phytochemical, Biochemical, Pharmacological, Microbiological and clinical methods.
- To evaluate the pharmaceutical product of Siddha medicine by clinical trials.
- To popularize this system through free medical camps and medicinal plant exhibition.
- To undertake research in all areas related to Herbal Sciences like Botany, Pharmacognosy, Ethnobotany, Photochemistry and Pharmacology.
- To identify Indian medicinal plants and maintenance of herbal garden to conserve for the future generation.

The seminar is aimed to provide a forum for interaction and deliberation on “*Recent Trends in Medicinal Plants Research*” among scientists, research scholars, academicians from various parts of our country.
